Gender Differences in Drinking Patterns among 15-16 year-old students in ESPAD countries

Abstract: (Please describe objectives, methods and specify the research question(s), maximum 250 words.) Objectives: To study gender differences in drinking patterns among school students across Europe. The associations between gender differences in drinking patterns and per capita alcohol consumption, alcohol availability, minimum legal drinking age, price of alcoholic beverages, gender equality, social background, perceived parents' social control and permissiveness of drinking, student's scholastic achievement and skipped lessons.

Method: In this study the multilevel analysis will be employed in order to take advantage of data's natural hierarcihcal structure. The individual-level data derive from the ESPAD 2007. The country-level data on e.g. alcohol policy and gender equality will be retrieved from applicable national statistics. Subsequently country-level variables will be aggregated to the ESPAD data set.
